

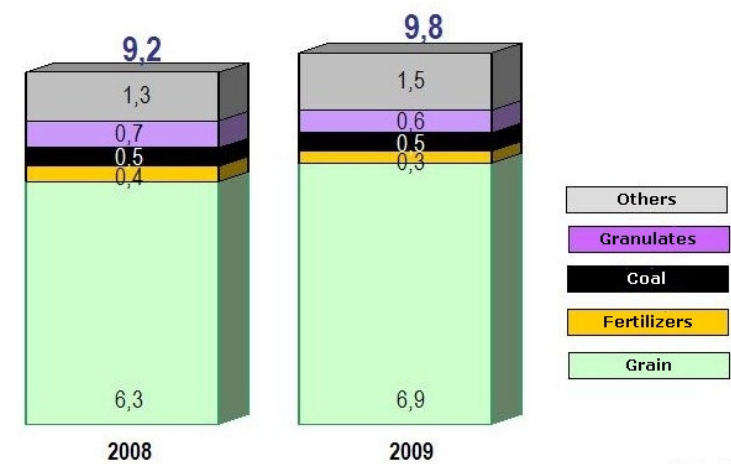
Dry bulk 2009: 9.8Mt



Dry bulk traffic through the Port of Rouen, at 9.8Mt, has continued its expansion, rising by +6.3% over 2008.

Grain accounts for the majority of dry bulk cargo with a total standing at 6.9Mt. Figures for 2009 were positive thanks to very satisfactory exports of wheat (6.1Mt, up by +15.2%), and the first months of the year were excellent thanks to the 2008/2009 cereals campaign, which totalled 7.5Mt (the best for nearly ten years).

From 2007 to 2009, grain traffic grew from 5.2 to 6.9Mt, an increase of +19.2%.
