

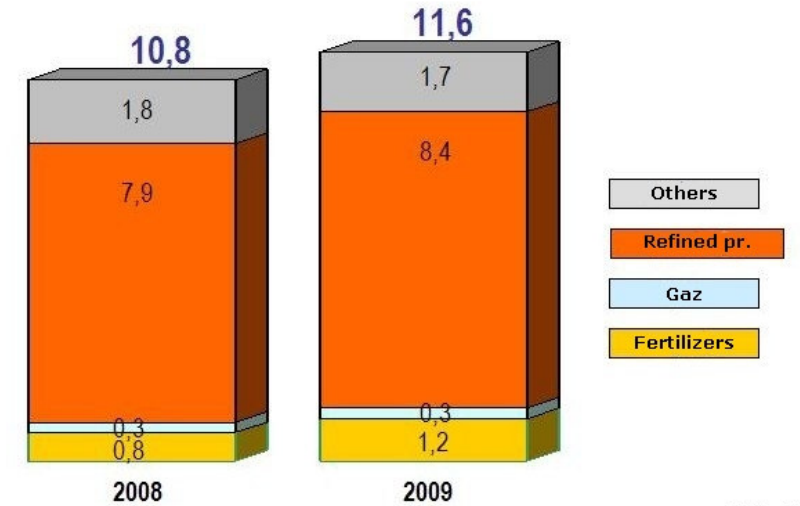
Liquid bulk 2009: 11.6Mt



Liquid bulk traffic through the Port of Rouen, at 11.6Mt, accounts for 49.7% of all port traffic and registered growth of +6.9% above 2008.

Liquid bulk consists mainly of refined petroleum products, most of which come from the refineries of ExxonMobil (Port-Jérôme), Petroplus (Petit-Couronne) and the Rubis terminal in Grand-Quevilly. This traffic totals 8.4Mt, a figure up by +5.5% on 2008.

The other categories of liquid bulk – essentially biofuels, liquid fertilisers and chemicals – contributed 3.2Mt and were therefore up by 10.3% on 2008.
